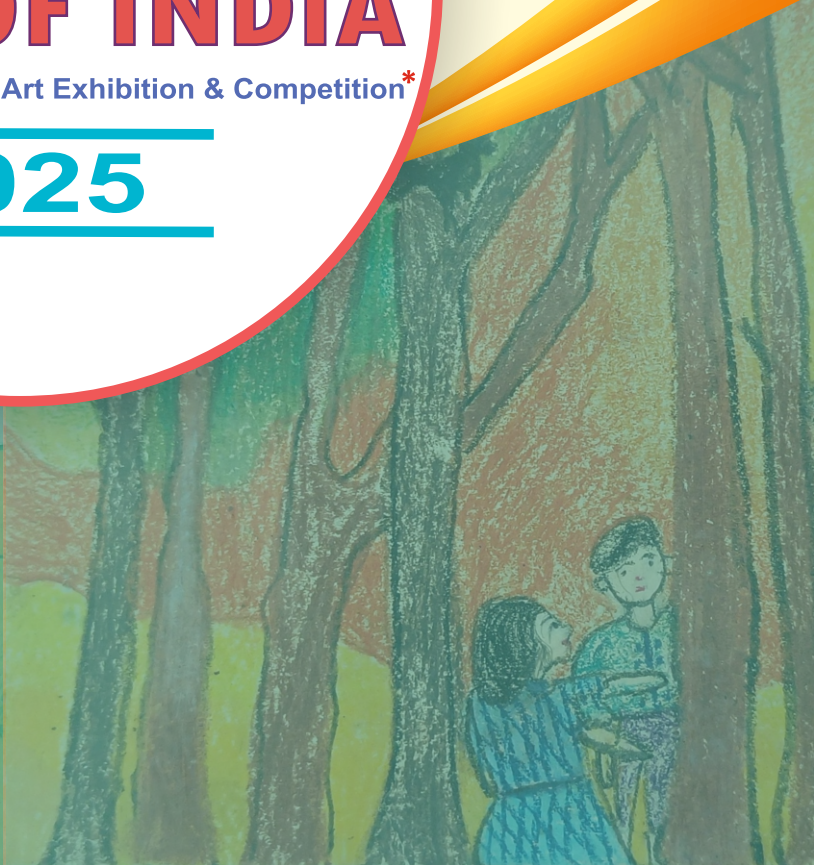



ARTWORK MEDIUM: Participants are encouraged to use any medium, including pencil sketches, watercolour, acrylic or oil paints, poster colours, or colour pastels. Mixed media creations are also welcome. Please note that only fully completed artworks will be accepted. We will accept both canvases and paper-based artworks.

SIZE REQUIREMENTS: Artwork should have a minimum size of 12" x 18". There is no restriction on maximum size, and we ask that canvases be framed before submission.

ORIGINALITY & AUTHENTICITY: All submitted artwork must be the child's own original creation and should not infringe upon any existing copyrights or trademarks. It is the responsibility of parents or guardians to ensure that the artwork is completed solely by the child without external assistance.

RULES & REGULATIONS

APPLICATION & ARTWORK SUBMISSION: Children interested in participating should apply and submit up to three original paintings or drawings, each created independently. All artwork should reflect the child's personal effort without outside assistance.

JUDGING GUIDELINES: Our selected panel of judges will assess entries based on creativity, originality, and the child's ability to express themselves, appreciating the distinct style each young artist brings.

SELECTION NOTIFICATION: After judging is complete, parents or guardians will be notified via email/call/message if their child's artwork has been chosen for display in the exhibition.

ENTRY FEE: An entry fee of INR 100 per artwork is required to cover the exhibition costs. This fee supports the event's organisation and ensures a high-quality display. A QR code for payment is provided at the back.

ARTWORK SUBMISSION BY COURIER/POST: Please send the original artwork to Hina's Art Pavilion via post or courier. We advise using protective packaging to prevent any damage during transit as we won't be responsible for damages incurred.

EXHIBITION DATES: The exhibition will take place on February 1st and 2nd at Hina's Art Pavilion (HAP). We invite participants, their families, and art lovers to join us in celebrating these young artists.

DEADLINES FOR SUBMISSION: To ensure smooth processing and inclusion in the exhibition, please submit both the application and artwork by December 31, 2024. Early submissions are encouraged.
