## ARTWORK MEDIUM & SIZE:

**Medium:** Any; pencils, sketches, watercolours, acrylics, poster colours, oil, crayons, pastels, or mixed media.

**Size:** Minimum A3 or larger.

**Originality:** Artwork must be entirely created by the child.

**Note:** Only fully completed artworks (with background) on paper or canvas will be accepted.

## SUBMISSION RULES:

Submit one original artwork via courier/post to HAP's studio.

Pack the artwork securely to avoid damage during transit.

HAP is not responsible for transit damage.

Entry Fee: ₹100 per artwork (QR code will be shared upon registration).

By submitting your artwork, you give HAP the permission to use, share, and adapt your work forever, worldwide, and without payment. This includes using it for our marketing (social media, ads) and commercial purposes (selling prints, books, or merchandise).

## JUDGING CRITERIA & RESULTS:

A national jury of artists, educators, and creative professionals will evaluate artworks on:

- Creativity
- Concept & Storytelling
- Technique
- Age-appropriate Skill
- Authentic Expression

Winners will be informed via email/phone.
